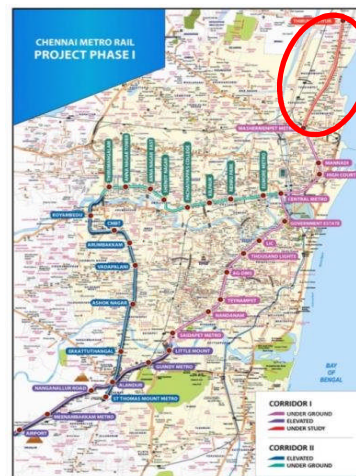

The Extension stretch consists of 9 km / 9 stations (7 elevated stations and 2 underground stations), and Nippon Signal will supply Automatic Gates, Ticket Readers, Station Servers which will be connected to the existing Central Computer and Central Clearing House System (a system that enables interoperability with other bus and the railway business operators).

The Chennai Metro project was the first order for AFC system that Nippon Signal received in India. 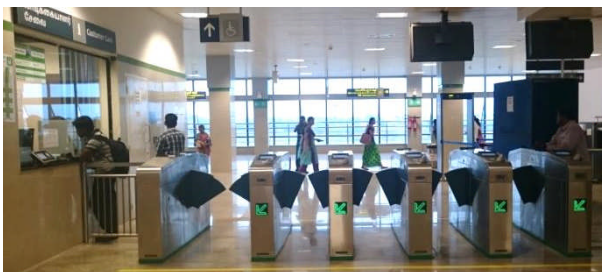
